Notes:

- Summer courses are strongly encouraged in order to graduate in four years
- A student obtaining this degree is expected to go on to a dietetic internship and therefore needs to have a minimum of a C in Nutrition classes, and maintain a competitive GPA
- Process of obtaining R.D. credential:
 - Upon completion of courses, the student should receive a verification statement.
 - After the student has taken the GRE and applied for an internship, a match is performed and the student participates in a 1200 hr internship
 - The student is then eligible for the RD exam
 - Student obtains RD credential upon passing of the RD exam
